Sunday the discovery of castles and villages in the province of Bergamo

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In a single day, castles, palaces and medieval villages of the province of Bergamo open their doors to the public with guided tours, events, exhibitions, markets and workshops for children. On the occasion of the "days of castles, palaces and medieval villages open in 2016", Sunday, June 5, 2016 in seven municipalities of Lower

Bergamo, you can visit centers and historic buildings, some of which are not normally accessible to public. Here's what to visit.

Village of Torre Pallavicina open Barbò sumptuous palace rooms with the staging of the exhibition of contemporary art "A story in six rooms", on display until 17 July 2016. visitors will also continue in the adjacent Tower of Tristan and in the large park of the palace. Guided tours from 10 to 12 and from 15 to 18 (last admission 17:30), at a cost of 5 euro. Children can then have fun in creative workshops and team games.

The ancient Roman village of **Martinengo** has an itinerary that includes the ruins of the tower of the castle of early medieval origin, the monastery of Santa Chiara and the fifteenth-century arcades of Via Tadino, which throughout the day will host a market of 'antiques and collectibles. Visiting hours to the city center: every hour from 10 to 12 and from 15 to 18, 1 hour; meeting in Via Allegreni 33.

Another village opens its doors to visitors: the **a Roman town of Lombardia**, which will host a series of visits from the outside of the fortress with its massive construction features four imposing towers and an inner courtyard. More will be organized tours of the House Museum of the tenor Giovanni Battista Rubini, the historic center with its typical "arcades of Mercy", the Old Cemetery and the Palazzo della Ragione (from 15 to 17, meeting point in front of the Rocca in Piazza della Rocca). You can also visit the M.A.C.S. - Museum of Sacred Art and Culture with a reduced ticket at the cost of 3 €. Until July 10 will also open the exhibition with free admission "MisericordiaeVultus: Flemish Art of the Banco Popolare", staged at the Mons. Alberti room at the following times: Saturday, Sunday and holidays from 9:30 am to 12 and from 16 to 19.

also open the **Malpaga Castle in Cavernago** with its rooms furnished with reconstructions of period furnishings and frescoed by famous artists (from 10 to 18, last entry at 17; cost: EUR 7 for adults and EUR 4 for children aged 6 to 12 years, free for children under 5 years). Sunday, June 5, also in the Yard of the castle from 10 to 21 will be held on Dejavu Market, with exhibitors of vintage accessories, furniture, jewelry, vinyl, modern, children's area with games and music, live music, free guitar lessons.

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in the **Rocca di Urganano** in a full program visit the Castle Albani, with a tour to the Satyrs room, the Red room with its monumental stone fireplace, to the Hall of Grotesques with his mythological frescoes, of the Oval Passage, and the Coat of Arms Hall. Open the Sala Pio V, in the Keep, where, according to tradition, she slept Brother Michele Ghisleri, guest in the castle and later elected Pope. The tour continues in the roof garden, with its driveway of the grotesque statues and in the Courtyard of the Well. Visits from 14.30 to 18.30 with departures every half hour; meeting in via Rimembranze Urganano. Cost: 3 €, for children up to 12 years free of charge.

Sunday, June 5 will be possible to advance in the rooms of **Visconti Palace Brignano Gera d'Adda**, on a tour that will explore in detail the frescoes of the '600 and '700, with particular attention to the mythological part of the decorations. It will also introduce the figure of Francesco Bernardino Visconti, the Unnamed Betrothed, and the Visconti family, and you can visit the permanent exhibition "The Palazzo Visconti masks", wooden sculptures of the seventeenth century. Visit at 15 and 16:30, while at 17 the sculptural multimedia meeting in front of the Palace in via Vittorio Emanuele II 36.

recently renovated, the **Castle Pagazzano** will open its reorganized rooms with related settings to rural culture. the tour continues to the ramparts of the Castle and the Park through the mobile wooden Ponticella, the Multimedia Museum "Castelli border" and the NEWT, Archeological Museum Great Works (by reservation only.) opening hours: from 10 to 12 and from 14 to 18.30, meeting point in front of the castle in Piazza Castello. Reservations required.



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
